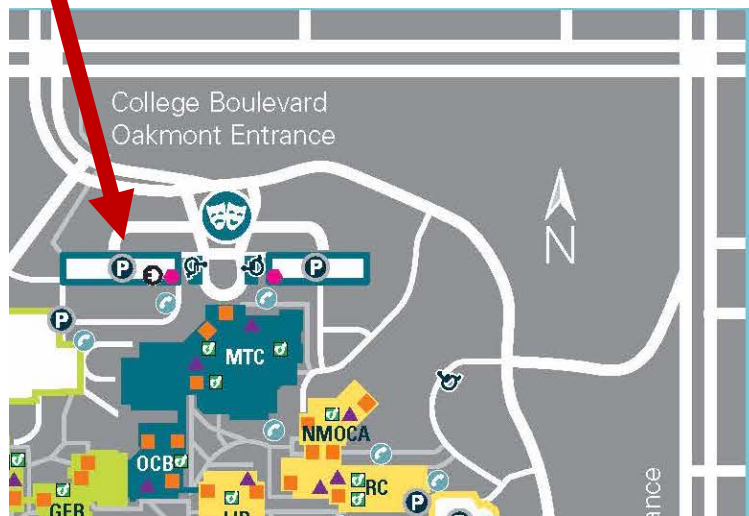

### **ARRIVAL INFO.:**

- Please arrive by **7:45AM** to check-in, get a volunteer name badge, and make your way to your event room!
- Park in the **Lower West garage.** *This garage has been specifically reserved for Job Olympics (just tell the person at the entrance you are a Job Olympics Volunteer). We adamantly request that volunteers park here since it has been reserved for us (and closed off to students/faculty).*
- When you arrive you will check in at the **Midwest Trust Center (MTC)** at Johnson County Community College (Formerly the Carlson Center)
